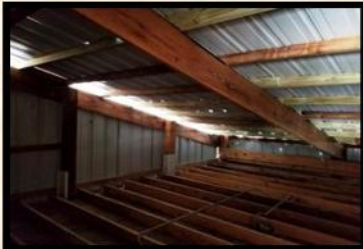

Ranch Report from Mike Edmonds:

Hello,

I would like to welcome the membership into 2021! Things are shaping up to be a great year!

If you have been following the 9 Lines Newsletter you have noticed we've been very busy using the off season to do some much needed repairs and maintenance around the ranch.

I would like to highlight a few of them for you:

New First Responders building added next to the Volunteer Fire Department.

General Parking area improved by utilizing the left over asphalt from the recent road repair project.

Extensive clean-up in and around the Maintenance Shop area, including the equipment parking area.

Purchased a Kubota KX91 Mini Excavator

Water jetting/clean out of problem septic lines in Lonesome Pines Campground.

Planning and Approval of the Connex Storage Area.

(Rental Contract is pending at the Attorneys office)

Trading Post and Restaurant computer, point of sale, upgrades.

Compound 3 tree and brush removal.

Fogey Tubes swimming area bank reworking.

Approximately 23 trailers/units to date are scheduled for pullout/auction from compound 3. This is an ongoing process for both compounds 2 and 3. Members are being contacted as time allows.

Tree trimming and clean-up on Spring Hill to Wilder Campground, continuing up to Hill Country Campground and also around the Walking Trail.

Sod and dirt removal in Compound 7 in preparation for the rock base.

Removal and replacement of the water lines in the adult pool bathrooms and restaurant.

New storage cabinet built for the sales office.

New shelving added to the Trading Post back room storage area.

Wall opening/removal in Trading Post to allow for much larger ice merchandiser.

Ice merchandiser added at the Gatehouse for after hour's sales. 2 ice merchandisers added to the Big Top to assist during peak times.

New location plates added to the perimeter spots in compounds 4, 5 and 6.

Purchase of a Vermeer 1250 wood chipper to increase efficiency with tree trimming and brush removal.

New opening/entry built into the upper wall for roof repairs in Big Top.

As you can tell, we've been extremely busy going into the new year and I look forward to the completion of all the ongoing projects to make way for the new ones still on our list. A few items I look forward to include firing up the rock shaker and moving gravel into the campgrounds. Also, the approval of the Powder Mill expansion project. In the meantime, we will continue with the tree trimming, clean up and beautification throughout your ranch.

In closing, I am excited for our members to return and enjoy the improvements we have all worked extremely hard on during this off season. I'm sure you will be pleasantly surprised! It's an awesome time to be a part of our wonderful ranch family!

***Storage Container Contracts – pending lawyer review**

***School House Repair – postponed pending further inspection and estimates.**

Siren Warning Signals

Series of Short Blasts means that a severe thunderstorm is in the area & campers are alerted to take shelter. **Continuous Signal** means there is a tornado warnings for the area and campers are alerted to take shelter.

Storm Shelter Locations

Pet friendly shelter is available in the Youth Center, which is located below the Trading Post around the back. Chapel basement is available for shelter during extreme weather conditions. Entrance is located on the Spring Hill side of the Chapel.

Emergency Lights & Sirens

No **flashing Red** or **Blue** lights and/or any type of **sirens** are allowed on any ATV/UTV or vehicle at Cloud 9 Ranch except as authorized for emergency personnel by the Fire Department or Security. Violations will result in a \$100.00 fine and/or removal from the Ranch property.
