Ranch Report from Mike Edmonds,

Good morning!

Well, it looks like Spring has finally made it for sure! The Dogwoods and Red Buds are in full bloom and beautiful throughout the ranch! The Ranch gets busier and busier each weekend. Even with rain in the forecast, people are ready to get back to camping and riding! It's nice to see a lot of faces I haven't seen in a while! Welcome Back!

Pinkston Construction has the Powder Mill Annex laid out, leveled up and installing the power boxes and wiring along the wood line/outer run area. Howell – Oregon is working on the power upgrade and will be setting power transformers for the expansion pads next week as weather allows. The Trading Post and Restaurant sales numbers for the first 3 months of 2021 are looking great! We have an increase of \$75,187.00 over last year from January 1st through April 5th. A big thanks to Mag and her team! Great job!

Are the compounds full? No, not really. However, large spots for 30 to 45 foot campers might be an issue.

Several spots for smaller units are still available. Are new members the reason? Maybe in part, but mostly in regards to moving the season up by one month, thus creating an immediate need for storage that we have not seen in the past. With the off season \$3.00 rule no longer in play during the month of April, more campers were placed in compounds until the later Spring months. Once the season gets in full swing, and as compound 7 nears completion, opening up 100 additional spots, the issue should correct itself.

We, like most of the country, are still in desperate need of staff! Laura has run ads in all the local newspapers, contacted all the local school districts, local workforce organizations, face book hiring pages, and other social network hiring pages. In speaking with other businesses in the surrounding towns, we are not alone. Several businesses have had to cut daily hours of operation due to staffing issues. One of which is Chili's in Mountain Home. Another restaurant ran an ad for a dishwasher, offering \$15 an hour to start.

This is a real issue. If you know anyone looking for work, please send them our way. We need cooks, cashiers, waitresses, grounds crew, rangers, snack shack crew, life guards and gate house workers.

Furthermore, any member, guest or employee Caught harassing, threatening, taunting or degrading another member, guest or employee will be Prosecuted to the fullest extent of Missouri Law and subject to an immediate 1 year suspension or Ban. This includes in person or written actions, on property, or any social media affiliated with C9R. 2nd offense – lifetime ban of entire membership.

Emergency Lights & Sirens

No **flashing Red** or **Blue** lights and/or any type of **sirens** are allowed on any ATV/UTV or vehicle at Cloud 9 Ranch except as authorized for emergency personnel by the Fire Department or Security. Violations will result in a \$100.00 fine and/or removal from the Ranch property.
