Important Reminders

SPEED Observe 10 MPH posted in all campgrounds and OTHER POSTED SPEED LIMITS. 25 MPH is the maximum speed anywhere inside the gate. Maximum 20MPH on trails.

STREAM RULES Missouri is very strict about protecting our natural waterways. Only cross the water at designated crossings. Do not park in the stream at any time. Joyriding up and down the stream or repeatedly crossing back and forth is strictly prohibited. A map with marked trails and designated crossings is available for purchase at the Trading Post or you can get a map for your smartphone or table from the Avenza Map app for Android or Apple. <https://www.avenzamaps.com/maps/how-it-works.html>

CAMPSITE BOUNDARY (Commonly called waterlines) - Your campsite boundary is the buried utility lines that run at the back of campsites between the electrical hookups. You are encroaching on another campsite/common area when crossing/parking on that line. You must use ONLY the campsite assigned to your membership number, even when the area beside or behind you is unoccupied. Ask a Camphost if you need overflow parking. Pull through pads are the ONLY exception.

CAMPFIRES Please do not leave a campfire unattended! Fires are allowed in the fire ring or in portable above ground fire pits. Firewood is available at the gatehouse.

PETS Please do not leave your pets unattended. If you are away from your campsite, leave pets inside, but not for long periods of time. Also, pick up your pet "deposits" when you walk them in common areas (don't use other campsites).

NOISE People come to Cloud 9 Ranch for many reasons – many for peaceful relaxation – please respect this in the campgrounds and keep your campsite parties, fun, music and riding at reasonable noise levels for the benefit of other campers. Use Common Areas for large gatherings. NO noise during quiet hours - Midnight to 6 AM every day.



Come out and have some fun and maybe make a little \$\$\$!



Need Fire Department or First Responders?

In any injury/emergency situation, please call the Gatehouse Staff immediately at **(417) 284-7321**. Please Don't Call 911

Please do not interfere with or hinder our Fire Department or First Responders at the incident scene. Substantial fines may be issued or physical removal from the area for non-compliance or interference with emergency personnel in the performance of their duties.

Siren Warning Signals

Series of Short Blasts means that a severe thunderstorm is in the area & campers are alerted to take shelter. **Continuous Signal** means there is a tornado warnings for the area and campers are alerted to take shelter.

Storm Shelter Locations

Pet friendly shelter is available in the Youth Center, which is located below the Trading Post around the back. Chapel basement is available for shelter during extreme weather conditions. Entrance is located on the Spring Hill side of the Chapel.

Emergency Lights & Sirens

No **flashing Red** or **Blue** lights and/or any type of **sirens** are allowed on any ATV/UTV or vehicle at Cloud 9 Ranch except as authorized for emergency personnel by the Fire Department or Security. Violations will result in a \$100.00 fine and/or removal from the Ranch property.
