# Conservation Father's Day Trout Tournament!



**C9 Conservation Committee is hosting  
"The Official 2021 Cloud Nine Trout Tournament"**

**Date: Saturday, June 19, 2021**

**The following Rules and Regulations shall apply for Members and/or sponsored Guest who desires to enter the C9 Trout Tournament:**

- A. A fishing permit is required and issued at the Gatehouse which is subject to observance of the rules of Cloud 9 Ranch and the Missouri Wildlife Code.
- B. Anglers are limited to 1 (one) pole with 1 (one) lure or hook
- C. Daily Limit is 5 (five) Trout. \* "NO Sizing Allowed" \*
- D. Trophy's for Biggest ,Smallest, Most weight in each class.
- E. Catch a Tagged Trout During Tournament receives gift card and prize.
- F. "Cost" for entering the Tournament is \$ 10.00 Adults \$ 5.00 Kids
- G. Tags are not refundable nor transferable
- H. Tournament hours are from "6 am— 4pm." Weigh - ins must be in by 4:00 pm to be counted.
- I. Trout will be the only Fish that will be weighed and recorded.  
(Conservation will weigh with a digital scale available at Conservation Cabin)
- J. Winners will be determined by TOTAL weight of all Trout
- K. Participants must be present at time of weigh in to win
- L. Cloud 9 reserves the right to disqualify ANY Participant who is in Violation of the rules in accordance to Cloud 9 or Missouri Wildlife Code
- M. Catch and Release during Tournament will be available if approved in advance under conditions of availability of Mobile Conservation Member for weigh in processes.
- N. Prizes will be Awarded in 3 (three) categories:
  - 1. Ladies Division
  - 2. Men's Division
  - 3. Kids Division....( 12 years of age and under ) \* Boys and Girls \*

Please do not interfere with or hinder our Fire Department or First Responders at the incident scene. Substantial fines may be issued or physical removal from the area for non-compliance or interference with emergency personnel in the performance of their duties.

### Siren Warning Signals

**Series of Short Blasts** means that a severe thunderstorm is in the area & campers are alerted to take shelter. **Continuous Signal** means there is a tornado warnings for the area and campers are alerted to take shelter.

### Storm Shelter Locations

**Pet friendly shelter** is available in the Youth Center, which is located below the Trading Post around the back. Chapel basement is available for shelter during extreme weather conditions. Entrance is located on the Spring Hill side of the Chapel.

### Emergency Lights & Sirens

No **flashing Red** or **Blue** lights and/or any type of **sirens** are allowed on any ATV/UTV or vehicle at Cloud 9 Ranch except as authorized for emergency personnel by the Fire Department or Security. Violations will result in a \$100.00 fine and/or removal from the Ranch property.
