



#### Good morning!

Here we are again folks! Just a month since our last meeting, but what a month we've had! Labor Day was one of the best holiday weekends I've experienced in a while here on the ranch. We had cooler temperatures and a brief rain Saturday night, just enough to settle the dust. The events were fantastic with a great turnout and everyone I visited had a smile on their face enjoying a laid back, relaxing holiday with several pads

still available throughout the ranch!

Now that the temps have lowered a bit and the rain is less frequent, the mowing has slowed enough for us to work on other projects. The Maintenance Department has began cutting down dying or dead trees in several locations. Some of these areas include the front-drive,

Hill Country and Powder Mill Campgrounds, and the road in between them. Good News folks, plenty of firewood for the Fall and Winter Seasons! We have also installed new LED lighting on the Tennis Court. The lighting in the wash bay area has also been repaired and repositioned. Since our last meeting, we have completed the gate, numbered the locations, and graveled the perimeter of Compound 7. We are currently renting out these spots.

Moving forward, we will gravel the center portion of the compound and lay out those locations as well. Speaking of compounds, the resource crew has been working hard on the compounds. They have been weed eating and spraying the last two weeks. All the compounds are looking much better. The new website is nearing completion. Laura has more on that in her report this morning. I'm sure everyone is excited to see our new updated site!

I know I am as it will serve as an information center for all members. The new site will allow us more options and have many more capabilities than our current one. The schoolhouse repair project is getting closer. The guttering is finally in and should be completed surely. Trail Construction is scheduled to be here next week to install the new gutters and give us a bid on replacing the rotten siding and wall studs. Keeley construction is also scheduled to be herthe first week of October to repair two spots on the entryway portion of the front drive that have settled. Magness Oil was in last week working on the Premium Fuel Upgrade Project. They are scheduled to return on Monday to remove the old pump, run new communication wiring, and set the new fuel dispenser. Tuesday, Magnus and American Petroleum will be programming the dispenser and point-of-sale equipment. Testing will then begin. We will begin seeding and laying straw in the Powder Mill expansion when the Fall rains start. In addition to that we will also be adding more gravel to the roads in the areas that have settled. It has been an outstanding summer at the Ranch and I look forward to another wonderful Fall and Winter Season! October and November are my favorite months here at Cloud 9, leaves falling, cool trail riding, and great nights around the campfire! If you've never visited the Ranch during the Fall Season, you are really missing out! Keep Smiling and Happy Camping.

#### 2021 Cloud 9 Ranch Big Buck- Big Doe Competition

Participants: Members and guests of members

Date: September 15th at sunrise - November 23rd sunset

Cost: \$25 dollars per adult/ \$10 dollars per youth 16 and under

<u>License and Regulations</u>: Must have in possession MO and C9R hunting license. All MO and C9R hunting rules apply. Any rules being violated may result in disqualification.

<u>Buck Scoring</u>: Bucks will be scored using the Boone and Crockett Official Scoring System for North America. All bucks will be scored by a C9R Conservation member. Bucks will need to be brought to the Gatehouse and Antlers must remain on the buck to be scored. Antlers that have been cut off will be disqualified. All scores are final. In the event of a tie, the biggest spread will be declared the winner. All bucks must be killed on the ranch to qualify. <u>Does:</u> Does will be scored entirely by total weight.

Winner: Winners will be announced at the Pavilion, following sunset, November 23rd. There will be an updated board at the Sales Office with the leader's name and score during the week. Big Buck and Big Doe winners will each receive 100% of each division's pot. Each pot will start at \$300.00 (funded by the Conservation Committee), and all entry fees will be added to each pot.
