**Ranch Report – Mike Edmonds**

**Good morning,**

2022s weather has certainly kept us guessing so far! Single digits, then sunny and 70, then teens and snow and ice, back to sunshine, then snow again. Who knows! I can say one thing for sure; the snowfall at the ranch is absolutely breathtaking when we do get it. If you have never ridden the trails during or after a good snow, you are missing out.

Laura is currently running employment ads on social media and also local newspapers. Additionally, we have purchased air time on the local radio stations to assist in our search for this season's ranch team. We are currently looking to hire 25-30 new employees. We will be staffing for the following departments: gatehouse, rangers, lifeguards, cashiers, wait staff, cooks, housekeeping, grass crew, office staff, snack shack attendants and wranglers. As I'm sure you are aware, in order for the Ranch to run smoothly during our busy season, we must be adequately staffed. We are asking everyone help spread the word, allowing us to hire and train a full staff this year. So please tell your friends, family and neighbors.

**Progress report since our last meeting:**

- \* 2nd billboard wrap completed on highway 160.
- \* Removal of unsafe/unsightly painters shed near the craft house.
- \* Leveled/graded the area where the prior painters shed was located.
- \* Faced the creek bank and pads in Wilder 2 for water drainage.
- \* Installed gutters on the Pavilion and Big Top.
- \* Fencing in Compound 6 - adding 42 spots for campers up to 50'
- \* Purchased 2 radar speed signs.
- \* Installed new shaker screen to increase gravel production at plant.
- \* Purchased a 2008 F250 ext cab with 51,000 miles.
- \* Purchased a 2008 F350 with service bed - 31,000 miles.
- \* Purchased 20 new radios for staff.
- \* Met with 3 contractors on Schoolhouse repairs. Bid accepted by Board of Directors. Begin work in 3-5 weeks.
- \* Purchased a 2014 Kubota M9960H tractor - 800 hours.
- \* Remodeled the Big Top restrooms. Added wheelchair accessible stalls.
- \* Began road repair in Hill Country Annex and Powder Mill Campground.
- \* Installed 3 porta potties at the outdoor stage area.
- \* Tree limb trimming - brush removal;

Shady Lane, Cabin Row, Hill Country, Hill Country Annex, road to Powder Mill, Powder Mill, Wilder 1 and 2 and will be working in Fogey Campground shortly.

In conclusion, we have been extremely busy repairing, improving and maintaining our beautiful ranch during the Winter season. In the coming months we are scheduled to work on more projects including ditch work, gravel placement, compound clean-up and more road repairs.

I look forward to a great Spring and Summer season, and the remainder of 2022; our Ranch's 50th year!

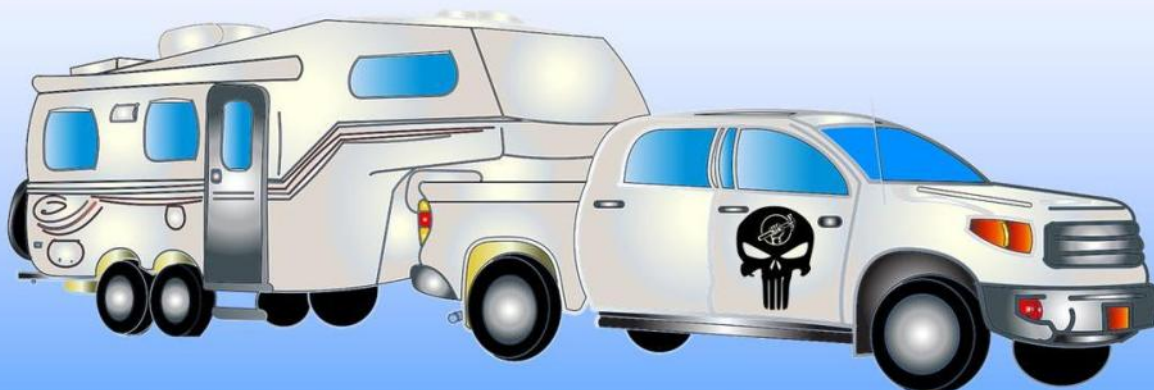

Please do not interfere with or hinder our Fire Department or First Responders at the incident scene. Substantial fines may be issued or physical removal from the area for non-compliance or interference with emergency personnel in the performance of their duties.

### Siren Warning Signals

**Series of Short Blasts** means that a severe thunderstorm is in the area & campers are alerted to take shelter. **Continuous Signal** means there is a tornado warnings for the area and campers are alerted to take shelter.

### Storm Shelter Locations

**Pet friendly shelter** is available in the Youth Center, which is located below the Trading Post around the back. Chapel basement is available for shelter during extreme weather conditions. Entrance is located on the Spring Hill side of the Chapel.

### Emergency Lights & Sirens

No **flashing Red** or **Blue** lights and/or any type of **sirens** are allowed on any ATV/UTV or vehicle at Cloud 9 Ranch except as authorized for emergency personnel by the Fire Department or Security. Violations will result in a \$100.00 fine and/or removal from the Ranch property.
