With busy season upon us, I wanted to send out a reminder regarding the 30 day Occupancy rule. Please read this carefully and make sure you understand it. If you have any questions contact the gatehouse or any Ranch Ranger.

30 Day Pad Occupancy: Most pad locations in the campgrounds are designated as 30-day pads. Owner is required to vacate and move all equipment every thirty (30) days to a different campground, regardless of the number of memberships owned, and may not return to the previous campground for a period of four days. Owner may not occupy the same pad location between October 1st and September 30th the following year. The only exception involves vacating a pad and leaving the Ranch for a minimum of 96 hours (checking out). Owner may then return to a previous pad location during the time specified above. The maximum leave time is five (5) days, unless approved in writing by Ranch Management from April 1st through October 31st. Twenty (20) consecutive days leave time is applicable at all other times of the year.



Ranch Report – Mike Edmonds

In looking back at my last report, which was not long ago, I was talking about snow and ice. It seemed like it rained for a month and now we're in the 90's. What happened to spring? Mother Nature took us straight to summer!

I hate to say it, but we are still struggling to find and hire a full staff for this year. This in turn has caused us to limit our hours of operation in areas such as the restaurant, snack shack and family pool. We will be adjusting hours as we gain more employees to fill the necessary positions. We appreciate your cooperation and as we've asked many times before, if you know anyone looking for employment, please send them our way. Applications are available at the gate, online or by emailing sales@cloud9ranch.com.

The Ranch has enjoyed thirteen "50th Anniversary" events so far this year. After kicking off the year with an awesome New Year's Party and band, we had the Extreme Caution Trail Rides and several other bands. These included; Harms Crossing, The Baker Family Band, Southern Edge and Hudson Drive. The Easter Celebration was a huge success, along with the fish fry and the karaoke contest. Folks, we are just getting started! I would like to send out a big thank you to everyone involved in making these events happen. In addition, I'd like to give a special shout out to Melvin, the Wolfman, for hosting his dj dances every chance he can and working around our events calendar to make them happen.

The following is a list of projects we have recently completed or are currently working on.

- * Added porta potties in the stage field area, including permanent plumbing and lighting
- * Purchased and received the Kubota 9980H tractor
- * Cleared Fogey Lookout
- * Purchased a new Kubota 4-way hydraulic blade
- * Established a new Vendor Row in front of Lonesome Pines with water and power for 8 spots
- * Tree trimming and brush removal from Fogey and Lonesome Campgrounds
- * Ran new power to the School House and overflow camping areas adding 2 more spots
- * Received and hung 50th Anniversary banners throughout the Ranch
- * Installed new LED lighting at the store, store parking, stables and stage stops
- * Installed an electric gate at the service entrance
- * Completed and went live with our new online reservation system on the website, next will be online bill pay
- * Purchased a new to us grapple bucket for the Kubota tractor
- * Built and installed bunk beds for cabin 53 in Melody Campground
- * Continuing to do dirt work in Wilder 2 Campground to improve the water runoff
- * Opened 8 new spots in Compound 6
- * Relocated the gravel plant from a flood plain area to higher ground at the end of Dry Gulch Road
- * Installed new overflow parking and no parking signs throughout the ranch
- * Contracted work is nearing completion on the School House

These are just a few of the many projects our ranch team has been working on or are continuing to work on. If you see these employees out and about give them a high five. They are working extremely hard to keep our ranch up and running for everyone to enjoy.




