We are removing any units that are not properly marked with one- 4 digit member number or any of the following; unsightly, flat tires, walls falling, etc. Additionally, any unit that has been in the compound longer than 3 years without moving will also be included. If your camper does not meet the required qualifications per the rule book, please make appropriate corrections immediately.

13. STORAGE COMPOUNDS

- A. Ranch assumes no liability for damage to items being stored or removed from storage.
- B. Owner is limited to a total of three (3) spaces in all compound areas (locked compound(s), open storage or temporary storage), regardless of number of memberships owned.
- C. All RV/Trailer/ATV items in storage must have the last four digits of Owner's membership number in numerals 3" or larger.
- D. Locked compounds 2 and 3 require the purchase of a compound ticket prior to storing or removing any item(s).
- E. Rangers will accompany any owner entering compounds 2 and 3.
- F. Ranch management reserves the right to refuse storage of any vehicle, equipment or items in its opinion that could cause a hazard or considered unsightly or unacceptable for storage.
- G. Items left in locked compounds must be removed within three (3) years. Items not removed within a three (3) year period will be assessed the current daily storage fee.
- H. All items in open storage must have inflated tires.
- I. No overnight occupancy shall be allowed in any camper, storage trailer, or other property stored in any compound.
- J. Factory manufactured cargo trailers shall be allowed in Compound 4,5, and 6
- K. All items must be removed from Open Storage when member checks out unless prior permission is granted from Management or Head Ranger.
- L. Items cannot remain in open storage (area in front of Ranch Riders building, behind Powder Mill, across from Lonesome Pines, etc.), for more than 30 days without being moved, if the member remains on Cloud 9 Ranch longer than 30 days, (to allow mowing, and grass to grow in these areas).

The weather has been fantastic this week and looks great for the weekend. The next event on the calendar is August 27th. The Activities Committee will be hosting a Poker Ride! Be sure to make plans to attend. Also, don't forget we still have the Conservation Bow Raffle and the Activities Weekly Raffle at the Trading Post.

During selling hours

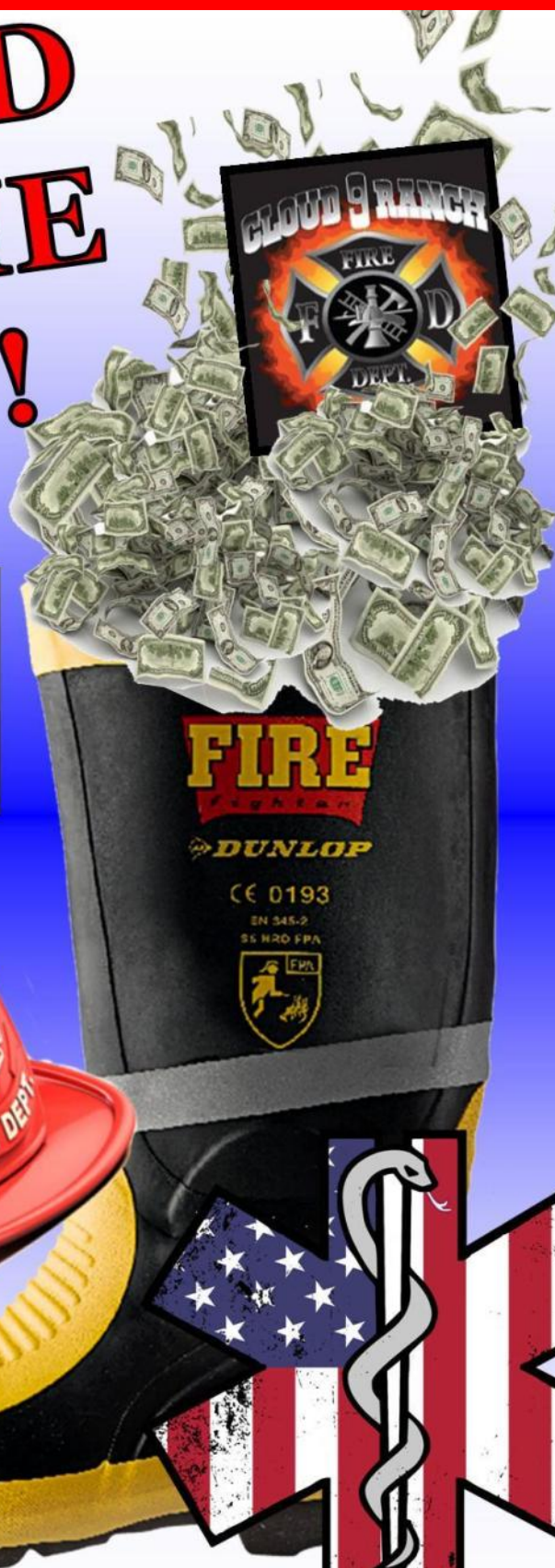
Keep your area clean during and after. Don't bring your pets without prior approval. Make sure someone is at your table at all times. We are not responsible for you losing a sale, or for theft.

Ms. Mary Killion, wife of the late Lonnie Killion

I had the great pleasure of meeting and visiting with Mary Killion Wednesday morning at Cloud 9 Ranch. Mary was born in 1942 and grew up on Wilder Ranch, prior to what we know as Cloud 9 Ranch today. Mary was celebrating her 80th birthday Wednesday by visiting places she had not seen in many years. She moved to the Ranch to live with her aunt following her mother's illness in the early 1950's. Mary began attending the Valley Star School House as a child around the age of 8. She then finished her schooling in Bakersfield. Mary lived at "Wilder Ranch" until she completed 11th grade and married Lonnie Killion. Lonnie was the "road builder" at the ranch. He built many of the roads members still use today. Has anyone heard of Lonnie's Lookout? Yes, that's him. Mary's husband built the road to Lonnie's Lookout and also cleared the area because, and quoting Mary's exact words, "Oh, Lonnie just loved that view and wanted everyone to see it".

Mary and I toured the Valley Star School House where it stands today following the move in the 1994 by volunteer Cloud 9 Ranch members. She was overwhelmed with excitement that the structure had been relocated and restored for her to see.

"So many memories, so many great memories" she told me with tears in her eyes as we walked around the one room school house she had attended all those years ago. I showed her the wall of photos that many members had graciously donated. She began crying when she located the large picture of her former teacher along with photos of her brother and sister. I rang the bell for her, she sat in a small desk and took it all in. While leaving the School House, I asked Mary if she remembered Wilder Spring and asked her if she would like to see it again, along with Lonnie's Lookout. Without hesitation, we headed for Wilder. Upon arrival at the Spring, she was out of the vehicle and in the water, drinking, yes, drinking from the fresh spring water. "I just had to drink from this spring one more time" she told me.

Cloud 9 Ranch, Wilder Ranch, Wilder Farm...no matter what you call it or when you were here, the memories really do last a lifetime and it is most definitely Ozark Paradise.

Thank you Mary, for sharing your trip down memory lane with me.

Siren Warning Signals

Series of Short Blasts means that a severe thunderstorm is in the area & campers are alerted to take shelter. **Continuous Signal** means there is a tornado warnings for the area and campers are alerted to take shelter.

Storm Shelter Locations

Pet friendly shelter is available in the Youth Center, which is located below the Trading Post around the back. Chapel basement is available for shelter during extreme weather conditions. Entrance is located on the Spring Hill side of the Chapel.

Emergency Lights & Sirens

No **flashing Red** or **Blue** lights and/or any type of **sirens** are allowed on any ATV/UTV or vehicle at Cloud 9 Ranch except as authorized for emergency personnel by the Fire Department or Security. Violations will result in a \$100.00 fine and/or removal from the Ranch property.
