There is an extra charge (\$2 per side of table) for using any other space, such as hanging items or items that touch the floor.

During selling hours

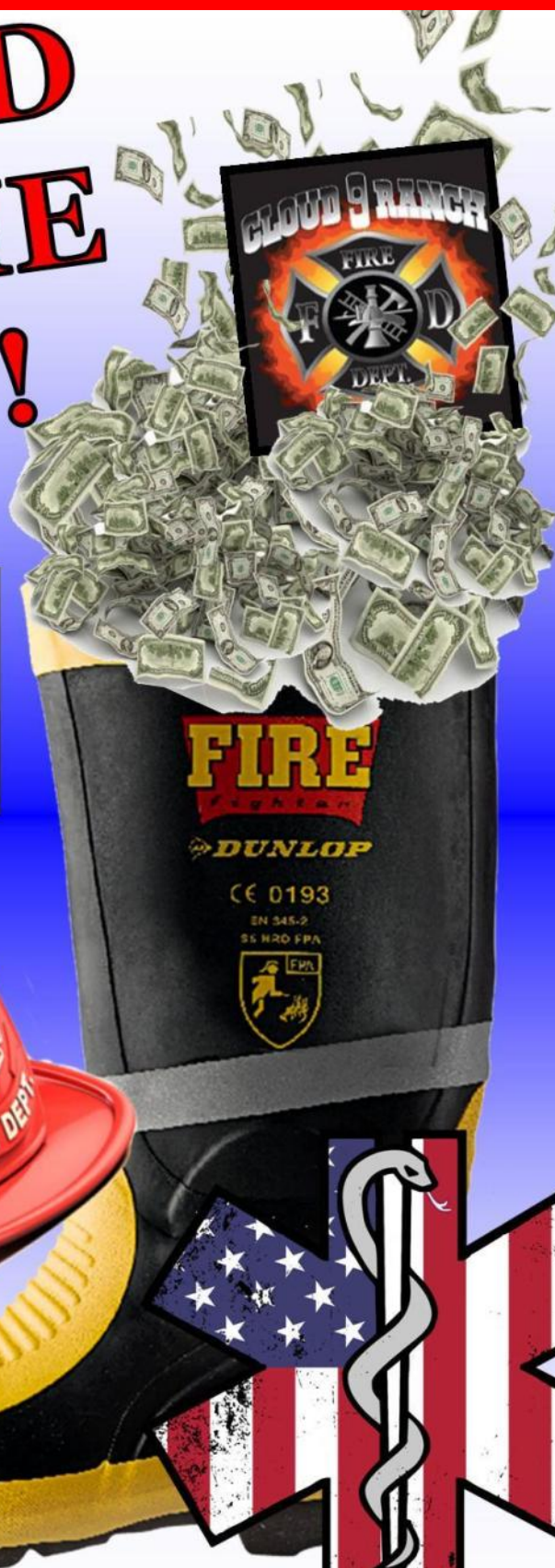
Keep your area clean during and after. Don't bring your pets without prior approval. Make sure someone is at your table at all times. We are not responsible for you losing a sale, or for theft.

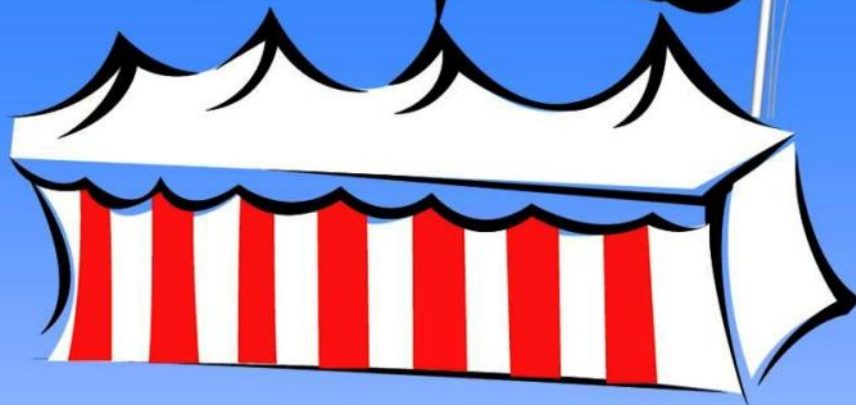

September 15th is opening day of bow season at the Ranch.

Here are a few reminders:

- *All hunters must have a valid Missouri hunting license as well as a C9R hunting permit. (available at the gatehouse)
- *Stands/blinds must have your member number on them.
- *You may begin putting stands out September 1st. No sooner.
- *Once you find your stand location, you must tag your location on the hunting map in the welcome center/sales office. If the door is locked, the gatehouse has a key.
- *All game killed must be field dressed and reported to the gatehouse.
- *If you wish to hunt the "Special Bow Hunt", you must contact Chuck Russell or Ted Ledbetter for approval prior to placing your stand in that area.

Siren Warning Signals

Series of Short Blasts means that a severe thunderstorm is in the area & campers are alerted to take shelter. **Continuous Signal** means there is a tornado warnings for the area and campers are alerted to take shelter.

Storm Shelter Locations

Pet friendly shelter is available in the Youth Center, which is located below the Trading Post around the back. Chapel basement is available for shelter during extreme weather conditions. Entrance is located on the Spring Hill side of the Chapel.

Emergency Lights & Sirens

No **flashing Red** or **Blue** lights and/or any type of **sirens** are allowed on any ATV/UTV or vehicle at Cloud 9 Ranch except as authorized for emergency personnel by the Fire Department or Security. Violations will result in a \$100.00 fine and/or removal from the Ranch property.
