Management Reports:

Ranch Report – Mike Edmonds

Good morning everyone,

Welcome to the second Board of Directors Meeting of 2023! As most of you know we are working in Lonesome Pines Campground this off season. The main Stage Stop is receiving a new coat of paint inside and wheel chair accessible showers with new fixtures in all of the showers and stainless steel cover pans. We are also doing a lot of road work to help with rain water drainage, filling in lots of low spots in the campsite yards, tree trimming and unsound tree removal and have dug up and made many septic line repairs. In the Fogey Stage Stop we are building wheel chair accessible showers, toilets and sinks. Lonesome Pines will open April 1st with a few areas that we have done extensive dirt work closed until early May. Fogey Campground will open May 1st. Over the last year and a half I have been meeting with Howell Oregon Electric Co-Op on the old and failing underground power primary wiring here at the Ranch and I am very proud to announce that they will soon be replacing all of the old underground primary lines at no cost to the Ranch and will be doing it all with an underground boring machine as it was done in Powder Mill 2 years ago. We will only have a hole dug up on each end of the line and not a lot of property dug up as we did in Lonesome Pines 5 years ago. This work will begin in Lonesome with the areas that were not replaced at that time. Then the primary lines to the Store, Restaurant and to the transformer that feeds the Offices, Fitness Room and Pavilion. Next will be Hill Country and Hill Country Annex and then Fogey. Per Howell Oregon all of this will be done by May 1st. Some of the things we are working on or have completed since my last Board Meeting report include:

- New LED lighting at the entrance overhead sign
- Removed 2 old light poles behind Entrance sign. Removed two bushes in front of sign and removed many years of redone wiring and conduit for a much needed cleanup of our Entrance Sign
- Moved the 35 mph Speed Limit sign from in front of the Entrance Sign and relocated it to the first straight portion of the Front Drive
- Cutting firewood and logs from downed and dead trees
- Purchased a new Dump Trailer
- The new rear discharge Grasshopper mowers have come in
- New pool table and pool sticks in the Pavilion
- The Trading Post is now an AMSOIL distributor
- Reworking and cleaning out ditch lines to help with rain water flow
- Trimming the road shoulders for rain water to flow off the roads
- Ordered new Washers and Dryers for our Housekeeping, they should be installed next week
- Ordered Lumber and Picnic Table Frames for 150 picnic tables. The lumber is here. Table frames should be here in a couple weeks
- New LED Lighting in the Fitness Room
- New LED Lighting in the Gatehouse
- New Flooring in Cabin number seven with three additional cabins to have Flooring Replaced on Cabin Row

- New LED Lighting at the Memorial Wall
- Grading work in Hill Country Annex, Dry Gulch Road, Cold Ridge Road, and the road to compound 7
- The rain water runoff Creek that flowed through the center of the Dog Park has been diverted to flow behind the park

In conclusion we are very busy this off season and need some good weather to allow us to wrap up many projects. Check out the schedule of Events listing because we have many Great Events and Bands planned this year! I am looking forward for all the members to see the Improvement that we have done this off season!

UTV-ATV TRAIL RIDING SAFETY

Spring has arrived and it's time to hit those trails again! **Please keep in mind if you become stranded due to machine failure or become stuck out on the trails; that Cloud 9 Ranch, and the Ranch Riders are not responsible to provide rescue.** Make sure to plan ahead; have a contact available that will be capable to assist you.

Here is a few items that may come in handy to keep with you.

- ♦ First Aid Kit
- ♦ Fire Extinguisher
- ♦ Tire Plug Kit and Air Compressor
- ♦ Tow Straps and Winch
- ♦ Water or Gatorade
- ♦ High Protein Snacks
- ♦ Map and Compass or GPS System
- ♦ Flash Lights
- ♦ Chainsaw
- ♦ Extra Bolts and Nuts
- ♦ Sunscreen
- ♦ Bug Repellent
- ♦ Trash Bag
- ♦ Emergency Tool Kit: Vice-Grips, Pliers, Allen Wrenches, Zip Ties, Duct Tape, Screwdrivers

It is always a good idea to have a riding buddy. If something does happen to one of your machines, you will have a way to get help. Be aware of possible flash flooding in the area to keep you from getting stranded on the wrong side of the creek. There are many more items to consider depending on how long you will be out, the type of terrain, and just how prepared you want to be. **These are just a few suggestions to help make sure you and your crew have a great time and make it back safely to camp!**

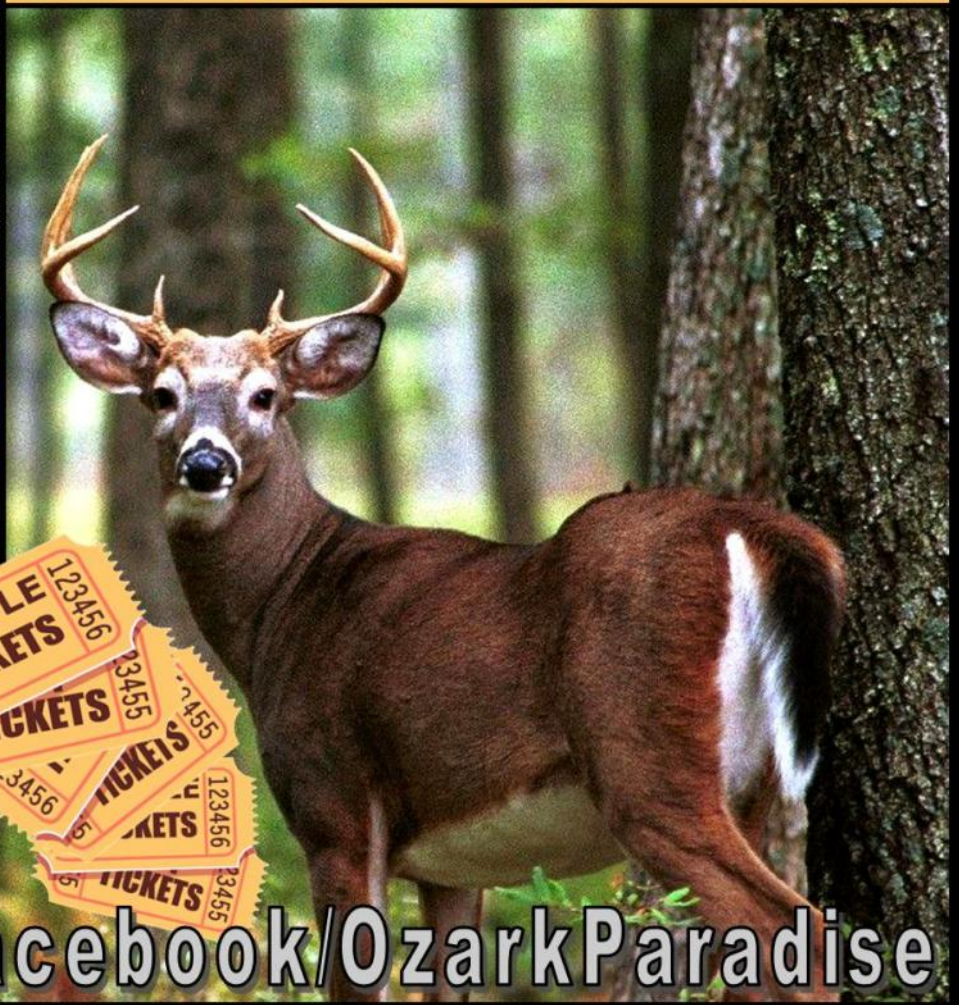
