EFFICIENT CHECK OUT PROCEDUREA AT CLOUD 9 RANCH

- Remove all trash, big rocks, wood support blocks, etc. from campsite.
- Place your picnic table onto the gravel or concrete pad upon leaving.
- Know the name of the campground you camped in.
- Know what your campsite pad number was. It is located on the electrical box.
- Know your member number.
- If you having a puller to put your camper into a compound, who is it?
- Are you remaining in a campground on a pad?
- Guests need to stop at Gatehouse when leaving.
- Guests need to know the member name and member number of which member they are checked in under.
- Guests need to know the campground and campsite number they stayed at when checking out.
- Stop at the Gatehouse and provide this information before exiting Cloud 9 Ranch.

This information will provide for a more efficient checkout process and assist with mowing the campgrounds for others to enjoy.



Holiday Weekend

Occupancy Requirements

Dates to Remember!

Friday, June 30, Saturday, July 1, and Sunday, July 2 is the 4th of July Holiday dates designated. If you camper is on a pad you must occupy it for the dates listed above.

Guest Pad Occupancy

If you have Guests occupying their own pad they will need to be off their pad by end of day on Sunday, June 25th.

Please know you are allowed to check out at anytime during the holiday weekend. To follow the rules you must pull your camper off the campsite pad and do not leave your camper unoccupied on the pad during the designated Holiday dates.

2023 C9R Rulebook

Page 6 Section C

Holiday Weekend Occupancy Requirements: If your RV, camper, tent, etc. is on a pad during the Friday night, Saturday night and/or Sunday night of Memorial Day weekend or Labor Day weekend it must be occupied. If your RV, camper, tent, etc. is on a pad during any of the three nights designated by Ranch Manager for the 4th of July holiday, it must be **occupied.** If your RV, camper, tent, etc. is on a pad during any of the two nights designated by the Ranch Manager for the Halloween holiday, it must be occupied. During the holiday weekends, as designated by Ranch Manager, Owner-Member/Associate is permitted only one (1) pad location. No guest pads will be permitted during the five (5) days before Memorial Day, 4th of July and Labor Day, and Halloween holiday weekends. During the designated holiday dates, Owner-Member/Associate may have a maximum of twelve (12) persons occupying their personal pad location. https://cloud9ranch.com/about/rules-fees/



Siren Warning Signals

Series of Short Blasts means that a severe thunderstorm is in the area & campers are alerted to take shelter. **Continuous Signal** means there is a tornado warnings for the area and campers are alerted to take shelter.

Storm Shelter Locations

Pet friendly shelter is available in the Family Center, which is located below the Trading Post around the back. Chapel basement is available for shelter during extreme weather conditions. Entrance is located on the Spring Hill side of the Chapel.

Emergency Lights & Sirens

No **flashing Red** or **Blue** lights and/or any type of **sirens** are allowed on any ATV/UTV or vehicle at Cloud 9 Ranch except as authorized for emergency personnel by the Fire Department or Security. Violations will result in a \$100.00 fine and/or removal from the Ranch property.
