



DID YOU KNOW.....

We have had some questions recently regarding the Stream Restrictions and rules. Listed below is section #19, A-D from the Cloud 9 Ranch 2023 rulebook

CLOUD 9 RANCH 2023 RULEBOOK PAGE 10, SECTION 19, A-D

A. Stream Restrictions: The stream is restricted to fishing only from Wilder Springs to twenty-five (25) yards above Fogey Tubes. No recreational wading, swimming, diving, or jumping off any portion of the stream bank allowed. Floaters and fishermen are asked to respect each other's activities.

- B. Crossings: Do not impede authorized crossings in a manner that prevents others from proceeding across the waterway.
- ATVs/UTVs/Off-road vehicles may cross at designated crossings only. Designated crossings are identified by signs.
- Entering or exiting creek at undesignated crossings will result in fines and/or suspension. See Fine Schedule in Appendix I.

C. Protection Of Stream Beds: Streams and springs throughout Cloud 9 Ranch property are governed by the Missouri Department of Conservation. Destruction of streambeds is a federal offense and enforceable by the United States of America and the State of Missouri.

Considering the laws pertaining to protection of streambeds, the following violations are strictly enforced:

- No parking in stream beds
- Littering streams with cans, bottles, waste, or garbage is strictly prohibited.
- Polluting water with soaps/detergents/chemicals; including, but not limited to, washing of vehicles, ATVs/UTVs/Off- road vehicles, clothes, dishes or cooking utensils in the streams or ponds
- <u>D.</u> Joyriding in the stream: Vehicles must be singlefile when crossing a stream. Joyriding is defined as any riding

that (1) is not in a continued motion in an approximate straight line to the other bank, (2) going back and forth in an unreasonable short period of time, (3) traveling up or down the stream in areas not specifically marked as an approved crossing, or (4) for similar actions. See Joy Riding in Fine Schedule in Appendix I.



Conservation Committee

 The Cloud 9 Ranch Conservation Committee has approved for members to sit along side the edges of the stream during the seasonal hot temperatures to allow for cooling off of feet.
 Please respect fishermen's activities.

NOTE FROM MANAGEMENT

CROSSING ONTO PRIVATE PROPERTY FROM CLOUD 9 TRAILS HAS BECOME AN ISSUE. THE ADJACENT LAND OWNERS HAVE COMPLAINED AND HAVE INSTALLED TRAIL CAMERAS TO CATCH THE VIOLATOR(S). THEY DO NOT WISH TO CONTACT THE OZARK COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT, HOWEVER, IF MEMBERS CONTINUE TO TRESPASS THEY WILL HAVE NO CHOICE.
