2023 thru 2024 Hunting Season

RULES

1. NO HUNTING WILL BE ALLOWED WITHIN 150 YARDS OF ANY RANCH FACILITY, ROADS, OR IMPROVEMENTS.
2. ALL HUNTERS MUST BE IN DEER STAND OR BLIND.
3. IN CONJUNCTION WITH THIS, THE MEMBERS/GUESTS WANTING TO BOW HUNT OUTSIDE THE CURRENT AREA ALLOCATED ON THE RANCH HUNTING MAP; WILL BE REQUIRED TO CONTACT THE CONSERVATION CHAIRMAN OR VICE CHAIRMAN AND SHOW THEM WHERE THEY WILL BE STATIONING THEIR DEER STAND OR BLIND. THE DEER STAND OR BLIND MUST BE MARKED ON THE MAP WHICH IS LOCATED IN THE MARKETING SALES OFFICE/WELCOME CENTER AND CHECK IN WITH THE STAFF THERE AS WELL.
4. ALL HUNTERS WILL BE LIMITED TO ONLY 1 STAND OR BLIND IN THE SPECIAL BOW AREA.

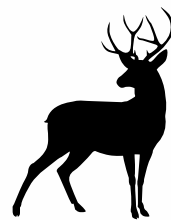

UTV/ATV TRAIL SAFETY

Whether you are new to riding or have experience it's always a good idea to be prepared. Here are a few ideas of items to keep with you to ensure you and your crew return to camp safely.



- First Aid Kit
- Fire Extinguisher
- Tire Plug Kit or Air Compressor
- Tow Straps and Winch
- Map, Compass, or GPS
- Flash Light
- Emergency Tool Kit: Vice Grips, Pliers, Allen Wrenches, Zip Ties, Duct Tape, Screwdrivers, etc.
- Extra Bolts & Nuts
- Chainsaw
- Bug Repellent
- Water or Gatorade
- High Protein Snacks
- Sunscreen

Please keep in mind if you become stranded due to machine failure that Cloud 9 Ranch and the Ranch Rider Club are not responsible to provide rescue to your machine. However, should you have a medical emergency or injury please call the Gatehouse. They will send Cloud 9 Ranch First Responders immediately as well as contact the County Ambulance and Air Medical Transport if needed.
