H. Items left in the locked compounds 2 and 3 must be moved within two (2) years. If you are not able to move the item(s) you may request a one-time six (6) month extension. The one-time request for extension must be submitted to the Ranch Manager in writing no less than ten (10) business days before your two (2) year allotted time expires. a) If you do not move your stored items within the time frame mentioned above, you will incur daily storage fees, as per current Fee Schedule, while the Ranch completes its due diligence to notify you of the sale of your property.

b) Any items that have not been removed from locked compounds 2 and 3 within six (6) months after the allotted time has expired may be removed and placed in a non-secured area pending legal action or recovery by owner. i. Daily storage fees will cease once item is moved to a non-secure area by order of Ranch Manager or designee.

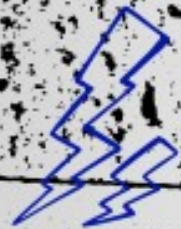

TURKEY SHOOT



October, 14th 2023

Read the Rules Shooters

1. All participants must sign a release waiver.
2. all participants under 18 years of age shall be accompanied by a parent or an adult guardian.
3. Shooter's shall use ammunition provided by the Ranch.
4. Any 12,16, or 20 gauge shotguns allowed. Max 680 choke.
5. A .410 shotgun may only be used by participant under the age of 16.
6. No sleeves or scopes allowed. Max 36 inch barrel.
7. If more than one person shoots at the same target, they will be disqualified.
8. Only judges are allowed past the firing line.
9. In the vent of a tie, the next closest shot of tied targets will be the winner. There will be no shoot off.
10. No intoxicating/alcoholic beverages are allowed on the range site.
11. The decision of judges will be final.
12. One turkey win per participant.
13. Maximum of three shots per participant to try for a win.
14. hearing and eye protection recommended.

The following rules and regulations apply for members and guest who desire to enter the 2023 C9R Squirrel Hunt

- Missouri and Cloud 9 Hunting permits are required to enter the hunt.
 - All Missouri and Cloud 9 hunting regulations apply.
 - No dogs are permitted.
 - Any rifle or pistol are permitted.
 - Cloud 9 Conservation reserves the right to disqualify ANY participant who is in violation of the rules in accordance to Missouri or Cloud 9 Wildlife Code.
 - Participant/participants must be present at the time of weigh in to win.
 - Hunting hours for the hunt are 7:00 AM to 3:30 PM.
 - Winners will be determined by total weight.
 - Registration will begin at 6:00 AM and hunt will start at 7:00 AM at the Conservation building in Wilder Campground.
 - Two or Three person teams, \$20.00 entry fee per team, each team harvest up to 20 squirrels.
 - Big squirrel \$5.00 entry fee by person.
 - Weigh in must be in by 3:45 PM to be counted.
- 1st Place \$200.00, 2nd Place \$100.00, 3rd Place \$50.00

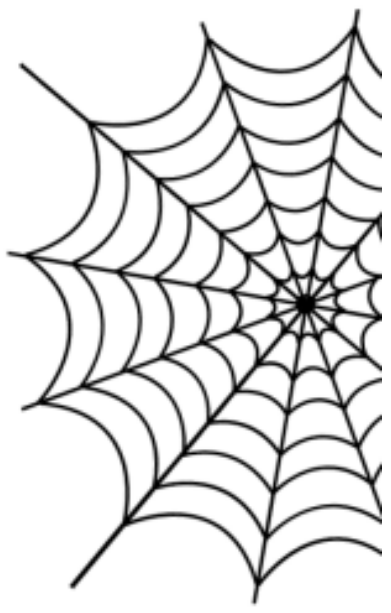

UTV/ATV TRAIL SAFETY

Whether you are new to riding or have experience it's always a good idea to be prepared. Here are a few ideas of items to keep with you to ensure you and your crew return to camp safely.



- First Aid Kit
- Fire Extinguisher
- Tire Plug Kit or Air Compressor
- Tow Straps and Winch
- Map, Compass, or GPS
- Flash Light
- Emergency Tool Kit: Vice Grips, Pliers, Allen Wrenches, Zip Ties, Duct Tape, Screwdrivers, etc.
- Extra Bolts & Nuts
- Chainsaw
- Bug Repellent
- Water or Gatorade
- High Protein Snacks
- Sunscreen

Please keep in mind if you become stranded due to machine failure that Cloud 9 Ranch and the Ranch Rider Club are not responsible to provide rescue to your machine. However, should you have a medical emergency or injury please call the Gatehouse. They will send Cloud 9 Ranch First Responders immediately as well as contact the County Ambulance and Air Medical Transport if needed.
