Rain! It's been an odd year for rain! We either receive a sprinkle that wets the surface or have 2 to 5 inches in a few hours. These large downpours really do a number to the compounds, gravel roads and gravel approaches to the pavement. We received 4 inches this last Sunday into Monday morning and we have been busy grading the compounds and campground roads as well as sweeping the roads. This large downpour has also caused issues with the culvert at the entrance to the T-Top and Chapel. We have been fighting this culvert for a couple seasons now and will be replacing it this Monday 6-17-24. Please use caution in this area and the top of Spring Hill.

This last Saturday we had the Big Animal Float Race that ran from Gene Bean crossing and ended at Fogey Bridge. There were 12 entries with only 4 Big Animals that finished. 1st Place finished about 20 min ahead of the other participants after being talked into racing minutes before the start and 3rd place was a Photo Finish through the Tubes.

The Ranch has ordered an ATM to be placed in the Trading Post and it has arrived. We have some paperwork to finish, and it will be installed and working very soon.

The 3rd Annual BBQ Cookoff scheduled for 6-15 had to be rescheduled due to having only 3 entries. Last year we had 15 entries and 12 that were here cooking. 

HOLIDAY RULES ARE IN EFFECT July 4(THURSDAY), JULY 5(FRIDAY) AND JULY 6(SATURDAY)

C) Holiday Weekend Occupancy Requirements: If your RV, camper, tent, etc. is on a pad during the Friday night, Saturday night and/or Sunday night of Memorial Day weekend or Labor Day weekend it must be occupied. If your RV, camper, tent, etc. is on a pad during any of the three nights designated by Ranch Manager for the 4th of July holiday, it must be occupied. If your RV, camper, tent, etc. is on a pad during any of the two nights designated by the Ranch Manager for the Halloween holiday, it must be occupied.

ALL GUEST CAMPERS MUST BE OFF THE PAD ON 6/30/2024

During the holiday weekends, as designated by Ranch Manager, Owner-Member/Associate is permitted only one (1) pad location. No guest pads will be permitted during the five (5) days before Memorial Day, 4th of July and Labor Day, and Halloween holiday weekends. During the designated holiday dates, Owner-Member/Associate may have a maximum of twelve (12) persons occupying their personal pad location.





IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT

“We are happy to announce that we now offer propane dispensing 24/7 again, we had a great class for our employees to get recertified and had some new certifications to help meet the needs of our members. Unfortunately, we were also informed by the State of Missouri inspector who was at the class that we must start inspecting the tanks we fill better, we were found to be not in compliance with this. We were informed that if an employee fills an out-of-date tank, they can be fined \$5000 personally as well as other fines for the Ranch. We have ordered stickers that we are required to put on each tank our employees fill. Employees will be checking for damaged tanks as well as tanks out of date. You can check your own tank to see if it is in date before bringing it up. On the collar of the tank there will be a date, if it has a date and not letter it is good for 12 years from the date on the tank. If it has a date and the letter E behind it, the tank is good for 5 years from the date. If the date has the letter S after it the tank is good for 10 years from the date on the tank. Examples : 10/20 good till October of 2032 10/20 E good till October 2025, and 10/20 S good till October 2030. A Ranger will check and let you know what the date on your tank is at the time of filling. Currently we do not have any tanks to replace damaged or out of date tanks. We will be working on getting a list together where tanks can be purchased locally.”

UTV/ATV TRAIL SAFETY


Whether you are new to riding or have experience it's always a good idea to be prepared. Here are a few ideas of items to keep with you to ensure you and your crew return to camp safely.

- Tow Straps and Winch
- Map, Compass, or GPS
- Flash Light
- Emergency Tool Kit: Vice Grips, Pliers, Allen Wrenches, Zip Ties, Duct Tape, Screwdrivers, etc.
- Extra Bolts & Nuts
- Chainsaw
- Bug Repellent
- Water or Gatorade
- High Protein Snacks
- Sunscreen



Please keep in mind if you become stranded due to machine failure that Cloud 9 Ranch and the Ranch Rider Club are not responsible to provide rescue to your machine. However, should you have a medical emergency or injury please call the Gatehouse. They will send Cloud 9 Ranch First Responders immediately as well as contact the County Ambulance and Air Medical Transport if needed.





