This week on Tuesday, Howell Oregon had to shut off the Power to the front of Lonesome Pines so we could dig and repair a 2" water main line that connects the 2 Lonesome Pine wells together. Found was a failed schedule 40 Joint connector. Connector and a couple feet of pipe were replaced and the power was turned back on by 11:15AM. A message was sent out on the Ranch's Texting Service. Well, it is not Dry and Dusty now here at the Ranch! Tuesday night through 10:30 am Wednesday we received 5.75" inches of rain. Maintenance will be very busy the next few days and into next week making repairs to the campground roads, gravel road approaches to pavement and ditch lines. Please use caution when the equipment is out working in these areas, and also out on the trails where 5.75" of rain has done damage.

follow this process.

APPEAL PROCEDURE

- 1) Pay your fine. If you do not pay the fine, then you will not be allowed on the Ranch. Pay your fine to either the Gatehouse or to the Ranch Accounting Office. Billing at 417-284-1321 fxt. 1004 of gate at fxt. 1016
- 2) Contact the rules committee Board Representative to schedule an Appeal Hearing within thirty (30) days of the date of the offense. It is recommended file your request for an Appeal via e-mail. Email address(es) can be obtained from the business office.
- 3) Provide the Chairman of the Rules Committee, and the Board Representative of the Rules Committee your written statement in your own words of what happened and why you are appealing the violation. Informing these positions will ensure the Board of Directors and the Rules Committee are aware of your request to appeal within the timeframe allowed.
- 4) Appeals Hearings are scheduled as soon as possible.
- 5) Be on time for your Appeal Hearing. If you fail to appear for your Appeal Hearing, we can only assume you have decided not to Appeal.
- 6) The Board of Directors and Appeals Committee, after a majority vote, reserves the right to increase the amount of the time of suspension from Cloud 9 Ranch if actions by the Owner-Member/Associate or guest(s) warrants such action.
- 7) If your Appeal is approved, you will receive a refund or credit to your account for the amount you paid.

8) Names and email addresses needed to file appeal are listed on sheet provided with ticket or are available at the Gate House or Accounting.

Aug, 30th, 31st & Sept 1st

C) Holiday Weekend Occupancy Requirements: If your RV, camper, tent, etc. is on a pad during the Friday night, Saturday night and/or Sunday night of Memorial Day weekend or Labor Day weekend it must be occupied. If your RV, camper, tent, etc. is on a pad during any of the three nights designated by Ranch Manager for the 4th of July holiday, it must be occupied. If your RV, camper, tent, etc. is on a pad during any of the two nights designated by the Ranch Manager for the Halloween holiday, it must be occupied.

ALL GUEST CAMPERS MUST BE OFF PADS BY MIDNIGHT OF 8/24/2024

During the holiday weekends, as designated by Ranch Manager, Owner-Member/Associate is permitted only one (1) pad location. No guest pads will be permitted during the five (5) days before Memorial Day, 4th of July and Labor Day, and Halloween holiday weekends. During the designated holiday dates, Owner-Member/Associate may have a maximum of twelve (12) persons occupying their personal pad location.




