I hope that everyone had a Great Thanksgiving! We had a lot of Members here at the Ranch with the Where's Waldo Hunt, Pancake Breakfast, and Extreme Rock Crawl. Our workers have been very busy this week working ahead of TechTree on the Fiber Expansion in Fogey.

We have run new power to the old viastat tower across the road from Fogey pad 58: from here we have Installed conduit and power to 3 access point towers at the Lower side of the upper shelf road. These 4 tower access tower points will give very good coverage throughout the Upper Fogey Campground. We do have plans in the works for Lower Fogey.

While working in Fogey we have ran new power to the Air Evac Landing Pad and will be installing landing pad marker lights.

OFF-SEASON

Rules

Off-season began November 1st and will end April 1st

- You can leave your camper on the same pad until April 1st, unless you decide you would like to switch pads or campgrounds.
- If you are wanting to leave and keep your camper out, you can go on unplug. Unplug means you can unplug (unhook) your camper from water and electric and be charged \$3.00 a day without it going against your days. And don't forget to let the gatehouse know that you are going on unplug when you are checking out.
- Plugged in is \$10.67 a day (if you have gone over your 30 free days) and will go against your days.
- The 5 day leave rule does not apply. You can leave your camper unoccupied for up to 20 days.
