


KURT MCGEE

STAY IN THE KNOW COLDER TEMPS HAVE ARRIVED

Things you can do to stay prepared

- Keep your water dripping and open the cabinet doors
- Add to your insulation
- Skirt your camper
- Multiple forms of heat
- Make sure you have your Winter clothes at the ready
- Have a campfire
- A heated hose
- Put a small amount of antifreeze in you black & grey water tank to prevent freezing
- Be sure to fill your propane bottles

- You can leave you camper on the same pad until April
 1st, unless you decide you would like to switch pads
 or campgrounds.
- If you are wanting to leave and keep your camper out, you can go on unplug. Unplug means you can unplug (unhook) you camper from water and electric and be charged \$3.00 a day without it going against your days. And don't forget to let the gatehouse know that you are going on unplug when you are checking out.
 - Plugged in is \$10.67 a day (if you have gone over your 30 free days) and will go against your days.
- The 5 day leave rule does not apply. You can leave your camper unoccupied for up to 20 days.
