Every time he came back in, he would always have honey buns or a bag of donuts for us girls that were working that morning. We always appreciated it and adored him dearly.

My aunt was a pool attendant at the Ranch and Bob was a Ranger. My aunt made friends with a member-couple from IL who encouraged her to get to know him; as he was always jokingly calling her "Aunt Jan" because, well, she did have a few of us nieces and nephews at the pool and our friends would call her that, too; and she called him "Ranger Bob". So, eventually he and my aunt began dating. She was crazy about him! Bob was her first real love. I'm pretty sure she still has a couple of his art pieces; inheriting one (I think a charcoal piece) he gave my grandma which she hung on the living room wall next to the doorway leading to the kitchen. When we moved off the Ranch in the mid '80s and bought our 160-acre farm in Arroll (Summersville), Bob lived out there with us for a while. He stayed in his own living quarters in a building on our property close to our house, but he always ate every meal with us as a family. Bob was very talented, talented beyond his art. He had a talent for music, songwriting, storytelling, connecting with people and animals alike, and also with nature. That's where he was the happiest...in nature. He had some of the best stories, especially during our family dinner time and during firesides. He had us captive and he also had us laughing. We all loved spending time horseback riding on our farm and playing at our swimming hole, too. We even camped on the farm and on Cloud 9 in a Teepee he gave us.


