- If your RV, camper, tent, etc. is on a pad during the Friday, Saturday, or Sunday night of Labor Day Weekend, it <u>MUST</u> <u>BE OCCUPIED (all 3 days)</u>! If you are not going to occupy it or are not able to occupy it, then you must put your camper away or take it home with you.
- Members are permitted <u>ONLY 1 PAD</u> during a holiday weekend. <u>NO</u> guest pads are permitted 5 days prior to a holiday weekend. EXAMPLE: 2025 Labor Weekend is August 29-31, guest campers must be removed by Saturday, August 23rd.
























