Maintenance continues to work on the Wilder Stage Stop to get it re-opened. Letter of Accommodation

On September 18th, 2025, in the early afternoon a fire started on property adjacent to Cloud 9 Ranch just outside the gate on County Road 350.

Due to extremely dry conditions and strong wind gusts the fire quickly spread. A large smoke column could be seen along with a strong odor that is associated with a residential fire.

A Ranger responded quickly to the area and found an abandoned trailer on fire that had spread to tall grass and was progressing quickly on a house.

The employees listed below all responded and participated in various roles. While this property was not part of Cloud 9 Ranch the prevailing winds were quickly pushing the fire through a grassy field directly toward Compound 2 which was full of empty campers.

The first people on scene were able to knock down the fire in the grass as it was approaching the house, while the house sustained heat damage to the siding, the efforts of the first responders saved the house from being fully involved. It took approximately 30 minutes for any fire apparatus from the actual jurisdiction fire department to arrive. During that time Cloud 9 Ranch employees continued to keep the fire from spreading to the house. After several hours and responses from three other agencies the fire was extinguished. The fire had spread up the hill toward compound 2 but had not reached it.

If not for the quick response of these Cloud 9 Ranch employees, the house would have been fully involved, which would have caused much more heat and flying embers, which would have spread much further and faster.

I would like to commend these employees for their actions. A copy of this letter will be placed in each employee's working file.

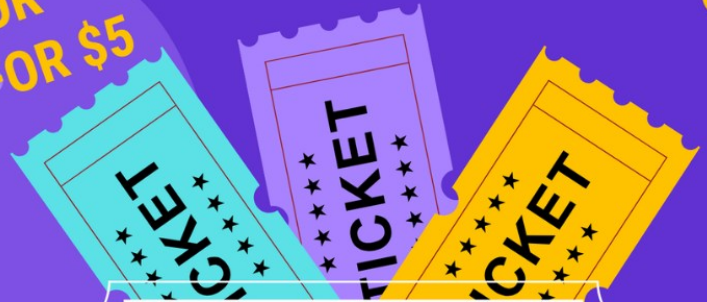

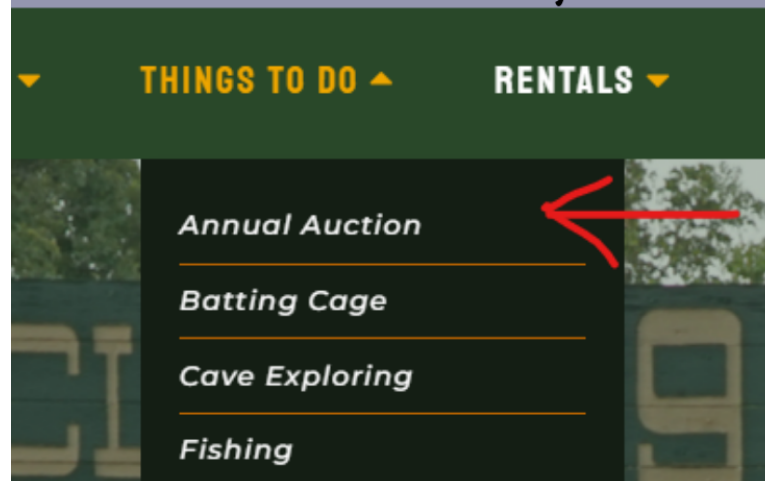


ANNUAL AUCTION

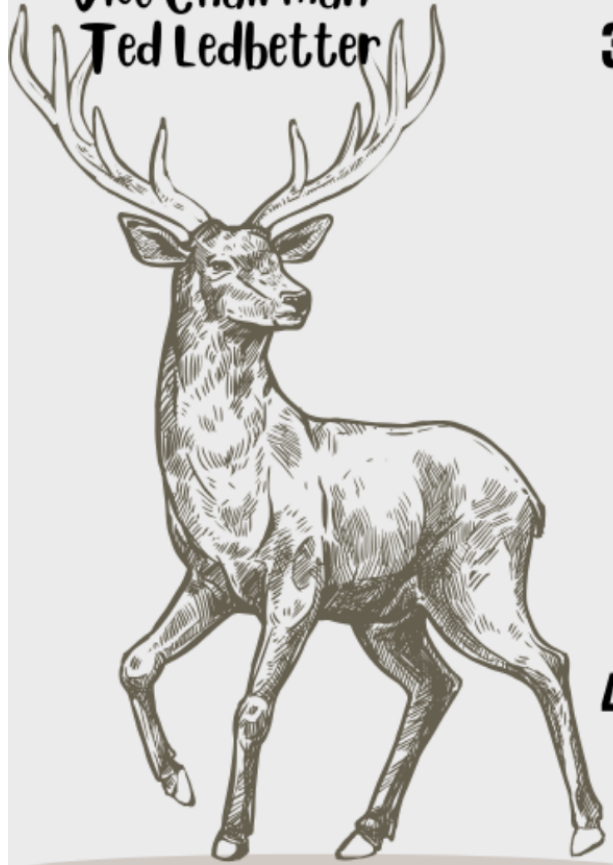
