OFF SEASON IS APPROACHING!

What does that mean?

Off Season is November 1st thru March 31st

If your camper is out but has not yet exceeded the 30 or 60 days on the pad, it may remain on that pad until In-season begins or until you wish to put it away or take it home.

Off-season unplug usage: what it means?

From November 1st - March 31st, if you are wanting to keep your camper out, you can disconnect from all utilities and be charged the unplug fee (\$3.00 a day) rather than the \$10+tax a day.

The water is 50 to 60 degrees cold, It comes from a spring which is quite old.


In the night, it gets cold as ice, But in the morning, its sunny and nice.


