



Cloud 9 Ranch Club, Inc. Xtreme Downhill Barbie Jeep Race Rules

- · All registered drivers must sign the waiver in person before the race starts.
- All registered drivers must be at least 18 years old
- Helmet must be worn and buckled securely. Other safety equipment may be worn. Failure to have a helmet will result in disqualification
- Drivers must provide their own plastic ride-on Jeep. It does not have to be a "Barbie" Jeep, but it does have to be a Power Wheels-type plastic vehicle
- The ride-on vehicle must have NO motors and NO gears. Battery should also be removed.
- . The ride-on vehicle must have some type of steering device and plastic wheels ONLY.
- The ride-on vehicle must have the original chassis (may be stretched to be an extended body if desired)
- Vehicles will be inspected before the race starts. Any vehicle that does not follow rules will be disqualified.
- The driver must ride inside the Jeep. The driver must also be inside of the Jeep to cross the finish line.
- · All drivers must wear a shirt and shorts/pants.
- Each driver may have a 2-person pit crew to assist with any necessary repairs after each heat. The Pit Crew member may bring his/her own materials for repairs (duct tape, zip ties, etc.).
- All drivers and pit crew members are required to Check in and register at 12pm the day of the Race at the check in area.
- · Races will be conducted in heats of 3-4 vehicles each.
- \$25 entry fee
- 1st place will win 50/50 split of the registration fees
- 2nd place will win a \$50 gift card
- 3rd Place will win a \$25 gift card
- Best Costume will win a \$75 gift card
- 1st 2nd 3rd place will also be awarded a plaque.



### Rules

- 1. No Hunting will be allowed within 150 yards of any Ranch Facility, roads or improvements.
- 2. All hunters must be in a deer stand or a blind.
- 3. In conjunction with this the members/guests wanting to bow hunt outside the current areas allocated on the Ranch Hunting Map: will be required to contact the Conservation Chairman or Vice Chairman and show them where they will be stationing their deer stand or blind. The deer stand or blind must be marked on the map which is located at the front office at the Gatehouse.
- 4. All hunters will be limited to 1 deer stand or blind in the special Bow area.

Calling all Hunters, get you hunting license at the Gatehouse!!!

If you want/need to look at the hunting map or are needing to place a pin to show where your stand/blind is, it is located at the Gatehouse! For the full list of rules, please see the Rule Book page 16.
