MANAGERS Report

June 4th, 2026

Hi Everyone!

I'm sure most have seen videos or heard about the flash flood we had at the Ranch on May 29th. It is startling to see just how fast the water can rise in the creek. It isn't always the rain we get on the Ranch property that causes issues. On the 29th we had a little over an inch of rain that had stopped by 10:00 am. It had turned into a very nice day, the creek was not up, and people were enjoying it like normal. However, just to the North and East of the Ranch it had been raining considerably more. Just before 3:00 pm, five hours after it had stopped raining on the Ranch, a short wall of water came rolling down the creek from off the Ranch. As soon as we heard about it we sounded the flash flood warnings on the sirens and started checking the crossings. We had a few members who were trapped in an area after their sxs's washed down stream in the fast-moving water. We were able to contact them by phone and direct them to the closest trail where we picked them up. Another group was stuck on the far side in another area, but they were able to make it to the North Gate on KK highway. We had employees respond to that gate and escort them back. This is a very long drive in a sxs. Within an hour or so of the flash flood we had accounted for everyone that we knew of and had no other reports of anyone missing. By the next day the crossings were back down and crossable again.

Please be very aware of the weather conditions around the Ranch, not just on the Ranch when you are out riding. If you see there is heavy rain occurring, just North of the Ranch and just East please consider not crossing the creek. Normally an inch or two of rain in or around the Ranch does not cause any issues. However, when it has been raining for a few days and there is a large quantity of rain in a short time it will flood and when it does it rises extremely fast.

If you do find yourself stuck on the other side of the creek please call the Gate and let them know where you are and how to reach you and we will work on getting you out.

On another note, the Wilder Stage Stop is due to open on Thursday this week. It has been completely re-done inside. It is still not ADA compliant, but it is much nicer than it used to be.

WORK CAMPER PROGRAM



This year the Board of Directors have agreed to try a new work camper program. There will be 6 positions open, the positions will have a primary duty of monitoring Compound 2 and 3. They will be required to escort members into the compounds to retrieve or put away campers or trailers. The hours that will be covered will be from 10 am till 6 pm Thursday through Sunday. On certain holidays they may also be needed on Monday. There may also be some other work directing outbound traffic at the front gate at the end of major holidays.

Work campers will be paid as 1099 employees and will not be eligible for benefits, and will be responsible for their own tax reporting. They will be paid \$10.00 an hour for hours worked and will be given a discount of \$5.00 a day for pad usage as long as they work at least 8 hours a week, they will pay \$6.00 a day instead of \$11.00 a day for usage. Work campers must provide their own vehicle, SXS, or ATV to escort people in and out of the compounds.

- Work campers will continue to follow campground pad move rules.
- Actual work schedules will be worked out based on the availability of the work campers. Generally, shifts will be scheduled in 4 hour blocks.
- Work campers must be members in good standing.

2. In-person interview

- a. Interview will be scheduled as soon as possible after application is submitted

3. Background Check and Drug Screening

- a. Work campers selected to proceed after interview will be required to pass a background check and drug screen prior to starting employment

4. Training























- a. After successful completion of background check and drug screening work campers will be trained by Rangers and Gate personnel.
